
Use and customize Control Center on your iPhone and iPad






With Control Center, you can quickly take a picture, set a timer, control your Apple TV, and more.



To open the Control Panel

on an iPhone X or later or iPad with the new iOS 12 Swipe down from top of the screen (on the right side)



*iPhone 8 or older or iPad with iOS 11

The Control Center can be a little bit overwhelming! Let's walk through all the sections - starting in the top left.





Network Settings

- 1. Airplane Mode turns off all antennas.
- 2. Cellular Data on/off (can still make calls).
- 3. WiFi browse the web, stream music.
- 4. Bluetooth Connect to headphones, car stereos and wireless keyboards.

Settings to bring up two
additional settings:



- 5. Airdrop share your photos and files with other Apple devices nearby.
- 6. Personal Hotspot allows your iPhone to provide cellular to an iPad.





Audio Controls

Press and hold the audio card in the upper-right corner of Control Center to quickly play, pause, skip and control the volume of your favorite song or podcast - or switch the audio output.



To Customize

- 1. Go to Settings -Control Center.
- 2. Tap Customize Controls.
- 3. To add or remove controls, tap • or •

Do Not Disturb: Silence calls and notifications. Press and hold to turn on for an hour or until the end of the day. Or turn it on just for an event or while you're at a location, and it automatically turns off when the event ends or you leave that location.



Do Not Disturb While Driving:* iPhone can sense when you might be driving and will silence calls, text messages, and notifications.

People trying to reach you are notified that you're driving.

Wallet:* Quickly access cards for Apple Pay or boarding passes, movie tickets, and more.

Scan QR Code: Use the builtin Camera on your iOS device to scan a QR Code to quickly access websites without having to type or remember a web address.

Text Size: Tap, then drag the slider up or down to make the text on your device larger or smaller.





Voice Memos: Create a voice memo with your device's builtin microphone.



Volume: Drag the volume control up or down to adjust the volume for any audio playback.





When you are in meetings it is always polite to 'silence' your iPhone.


The traditional way is to flip up the switch on the left side of your iPhone.







Do Not Disturb While Driving



You can activate it automatically (by speed), when connected to car's Bluetooth or manually by clicking the 'car' symbol in your Control Center.
