### NYPD docs: 'Focus' scrutiny on Muslim Americans

NEW YORK (AP) — The New York Police Department collected information on businesses owned by second- and third-generation Americans specifically because they were Muslims, according to newly obtained secret documents. They show in the clearest terms yet that police were monitoring people based on religion, despite claims from Mayor Michael Bloomberg to the contrary.

The NYPD has faced intense criticism from Muslims, lawmakers — and even the FBI — for widespread spying operations that put entire neighborhoods under surveillance. Police put the names of innocent people in secret files and monitored the mosques, student groups and businesses that make up the Muslim landscape of the northeastern U.S.

Bloomberg has defended his department's efforts, saying they have kept the city safe, were completely legal and were not based on religion.

"We don't stop to think about the religion," Bloomberg said at a news conference in August after The Associated Press began revealing the spying. "We stop to think about the threats and focus our efforts there."

In late 2007, however, plainclothes officers in the department's secretive Demographics Unit were assigned to investigate the region's Syrian population. Police photographed businesses and eavesdropped at lunch counters and inside grocery stores and pastry shops. The resulting document listed no threat. And though most people of Syrian heritage living in the area were Jewish, Jews were excluded from the monitoring.

"This report will focus on the smaller Muslim community," the report said.

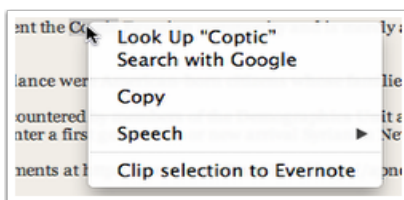
Similarly, police excluded the city's sizable Coptic Christian population when photographing, monitoring and eavesdropping on Egyptian businesses in 2007, according to the police files.

"This report does not represent the Coptic Egyptian community and is merely an insight into the Muslim Egyptian community of New York City," the NYPD wrote.

Many of those under surveillance were American-born citizens whose families have been here for the better part of a century.

# Quick Look

Select the file and then tap the spacebar

Quick Look does exactly what its name implies: it presents you with a quick preview of a file's content without having to open a larger application. Using this feature couldn't be simpler: from the Finder, click once on a file to select it, then tap the Spacebar once. Quick Look will attempt to display a preview of the file's content. It recognizes a wide variety of graphics formats, PDFs, text files, and Microsoft Office documents, among other things. When it comes to media files such as movies or audio, if QuickTime can play it, Quick Look can preview it for you complete with sound.

The last feature of Quick Look is a real treat. Suppose you've just received a file from someone and don't have the right application to open it? Give Quick Look a try; it might be able to come to the rescue.

## Making Aliases

### Make Your Own Aliases

An alias is an "empty" icon that represents the real thing. (The alias icon looks just like the original icon, but with a small arrow in the lower-left corner.) You create aliases so you don't have to go and find the original file every time you want to use it—you can put aliases where they're easier to find, and then keep the originals in their important folders. You can make aliases of applications, documents, folders, utilities, games, etc. Aliases are wonderful tools for organizing your work—anything you want to use is only one double-click away from wherever you are. Remember, an alias is just a picture that goes and gets the real file.

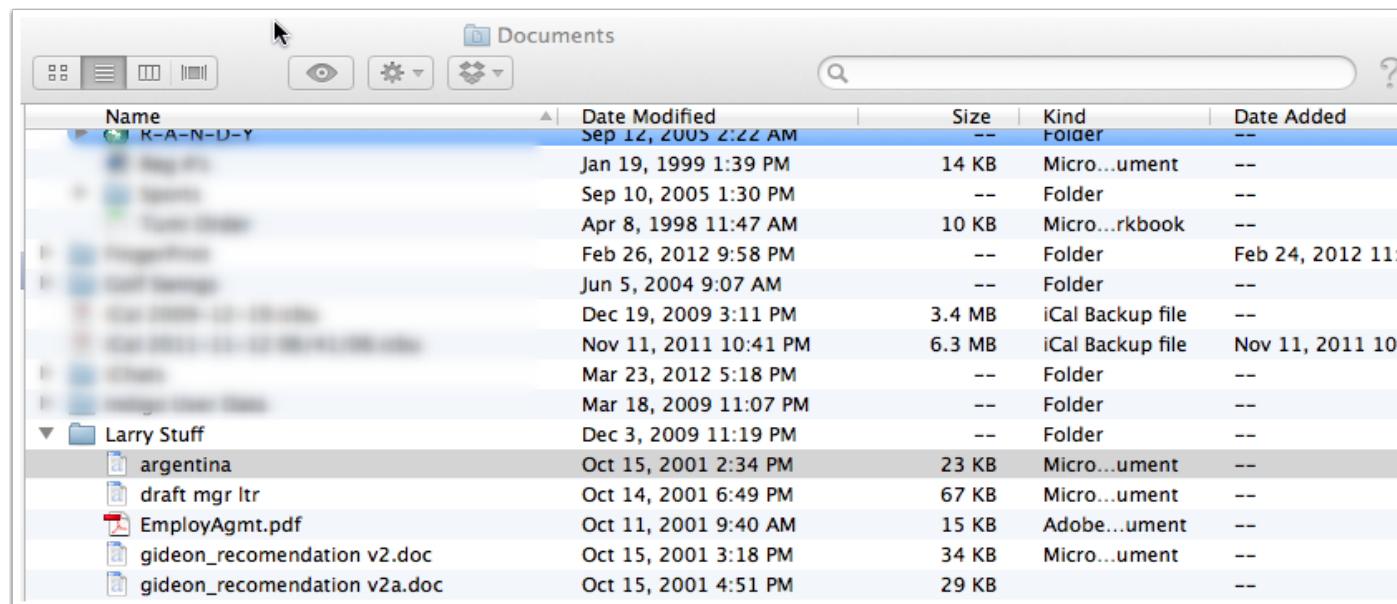
Start by clicking the item for which you want to make an alias. Then choose one of these four ways to make an alias:

- Choose File > Make Alias.
- Press Command-L.
- Control-click the item and choose Make Alias from the contextual menu.
- Hold down Command-Option and drag the file. If you drag to somewhere else in the same folder, you'll create an alias with the word *alias* at the end of the name. If you drag to a different folder or to the Desktop, you'll create an alias **without** the word *alias* in its name.

After creating the alias, drag the alias icon to wherever you want to keep it. Rename it, if you like. The new file isn't required to have the word *alias* in its name. (**Tip:** It doesn't matter if you move the original file later—the alias can always find it.)

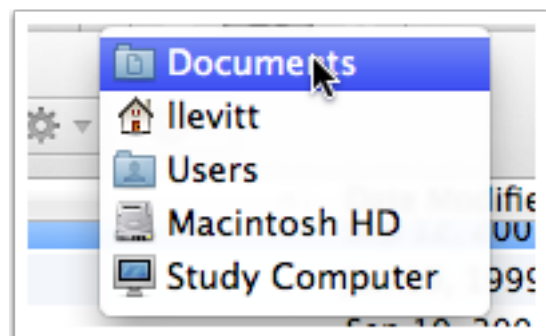

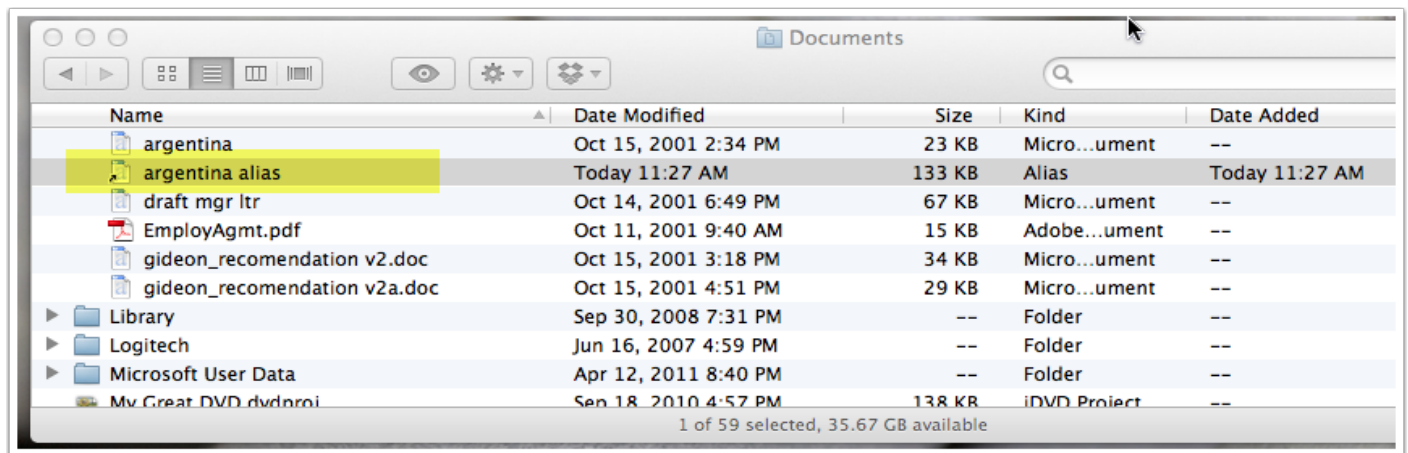

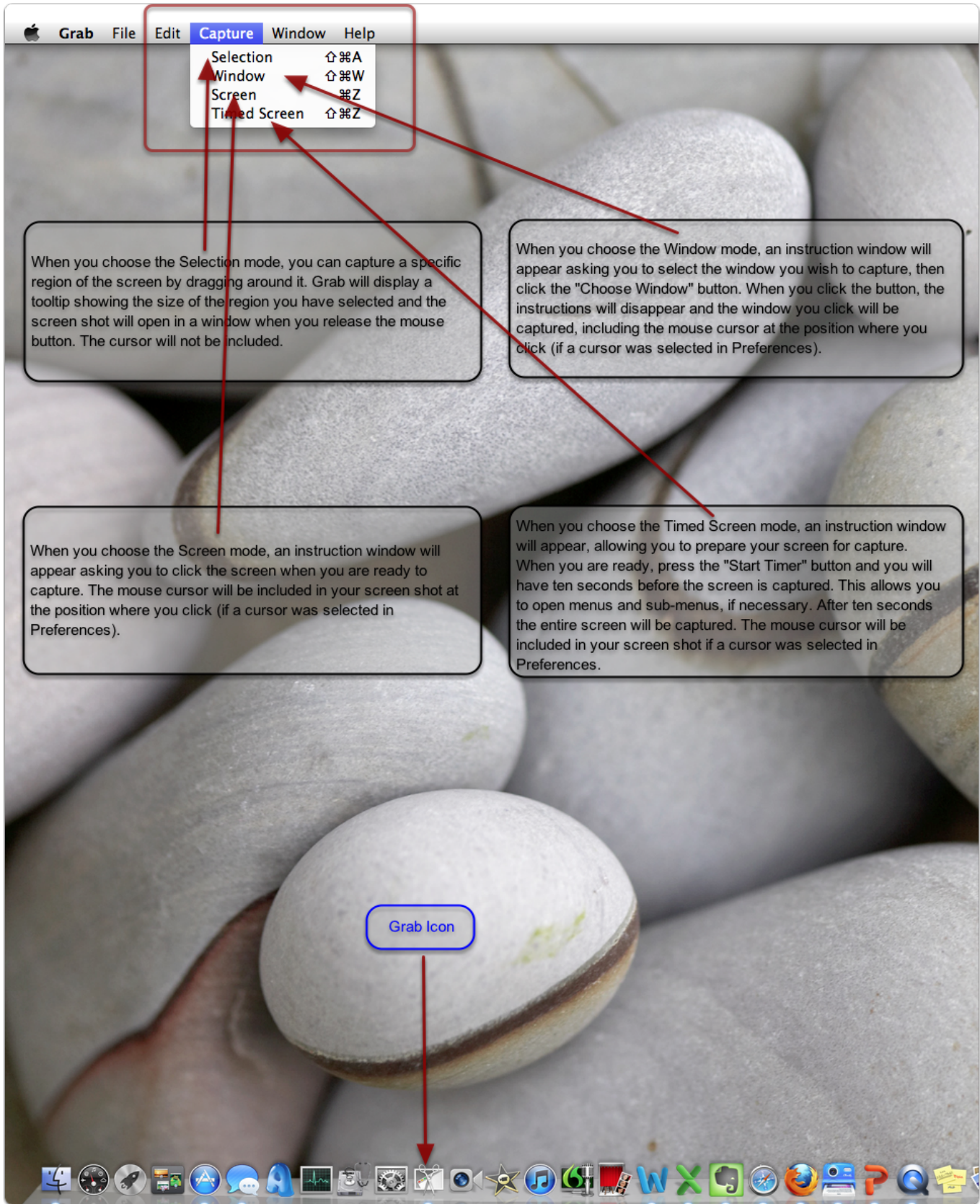
#### [What is a Screen Shot?](#)

A screen shot is a way of taking a snapshot, or picture, of your computer screen. Screen shots can be very helpful when you need to demonstrate something that would be difficult to explain in words.

1. To capture **the entire desktop**, press **Command-Shift-3**. The screen shot automatically will be saved as a [PNG](#) file on your desktop.
2. To capture **a portion of the desktop**, press **Command-Shift-4**. A cross-hair cursor will appear and you can click and drag to select the area you wish to capture. When you release the mouse button, the screen shot automatically will be saved as a PNG file on your desktop.
3. To capture **a specific application window**, press **Command-Shift-4**, then press the **Spacebar**. The cursor will change to a camera, and you can move it around the screen. As you move the cursor over an application window, the window will be highlighted. The entire window does not need to be visible for you to capture it. When you have the cursor over a window you want to capture, just click the mouse button and the screen shot will be saved as a PNG file on your desktop.
4. A PNG file name will look like: Screen Shot 2012-03-29 at 12.02.18 PM.png, i.e., showing the date and time taken. You can email the file as an attachment.

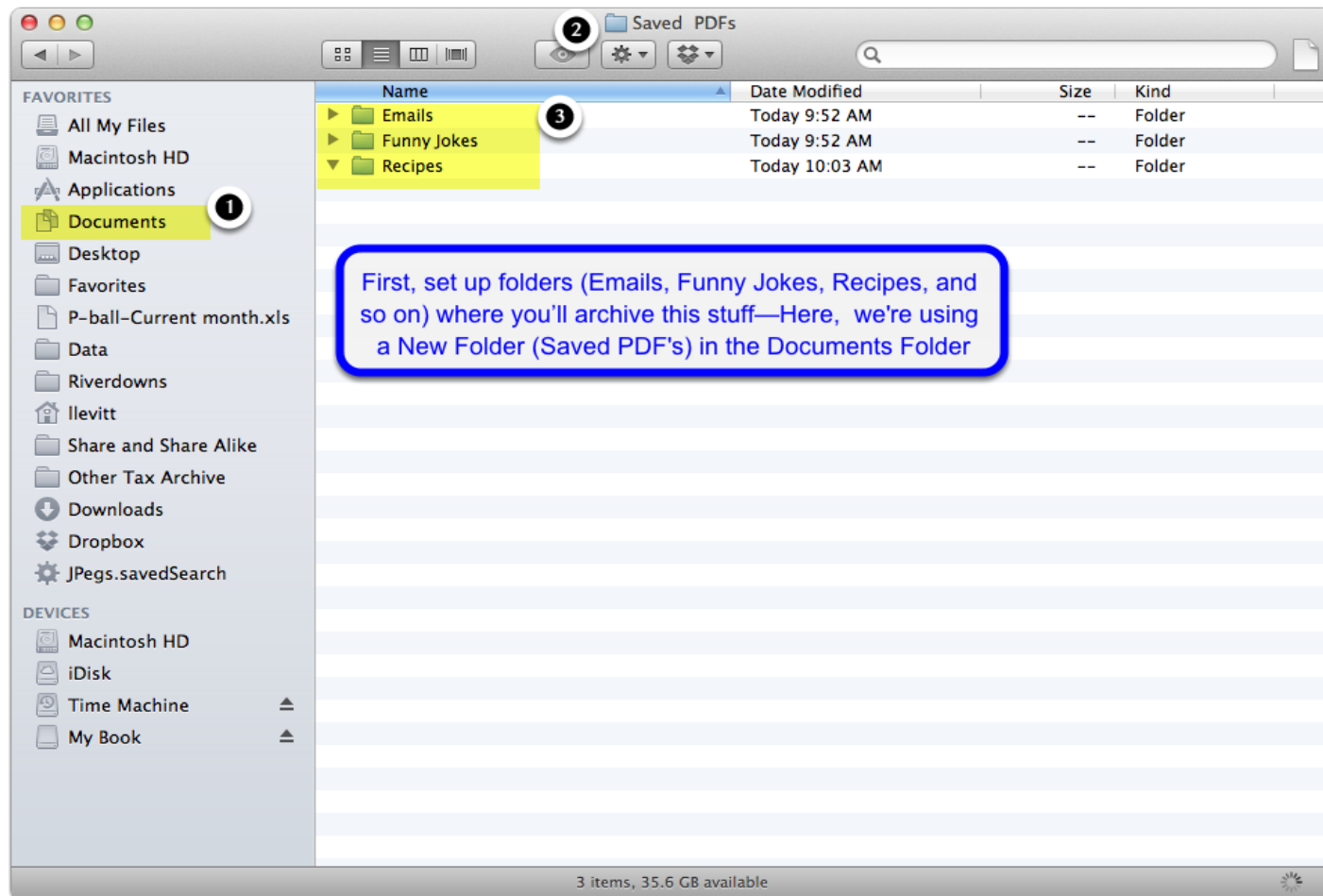

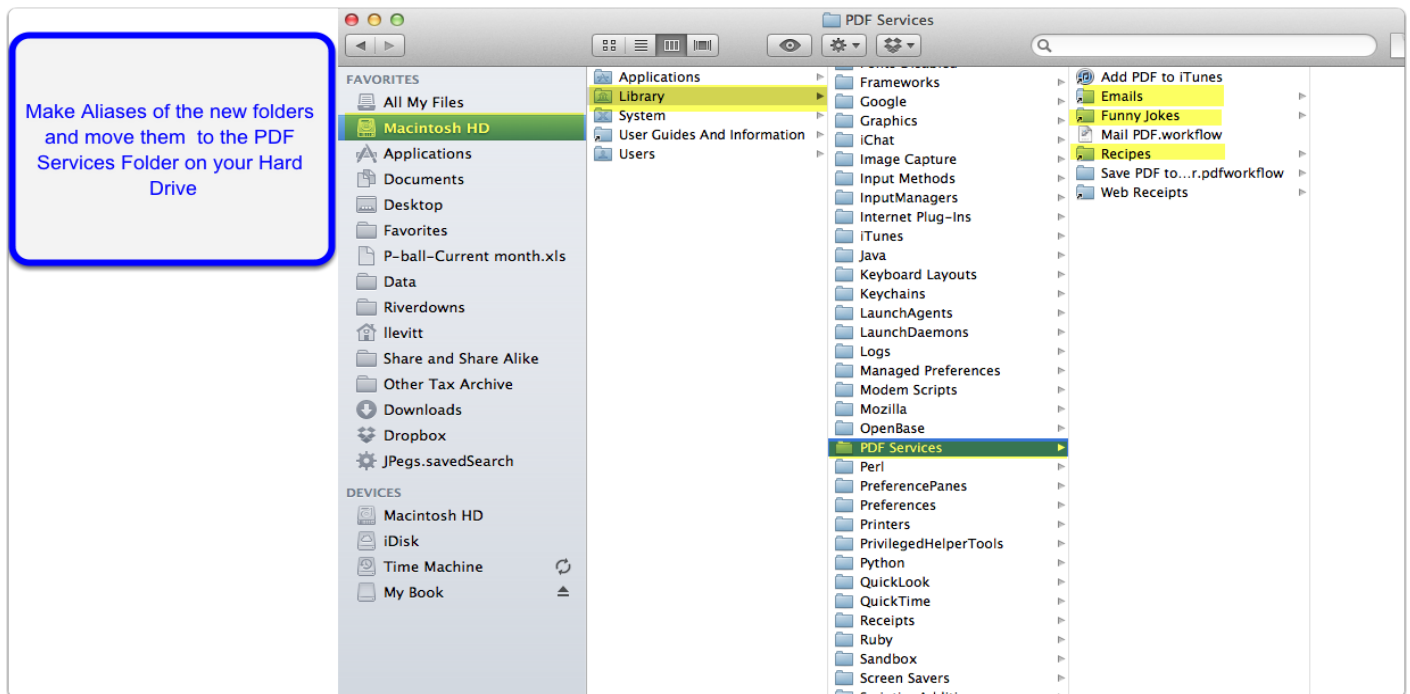


## PDF Services

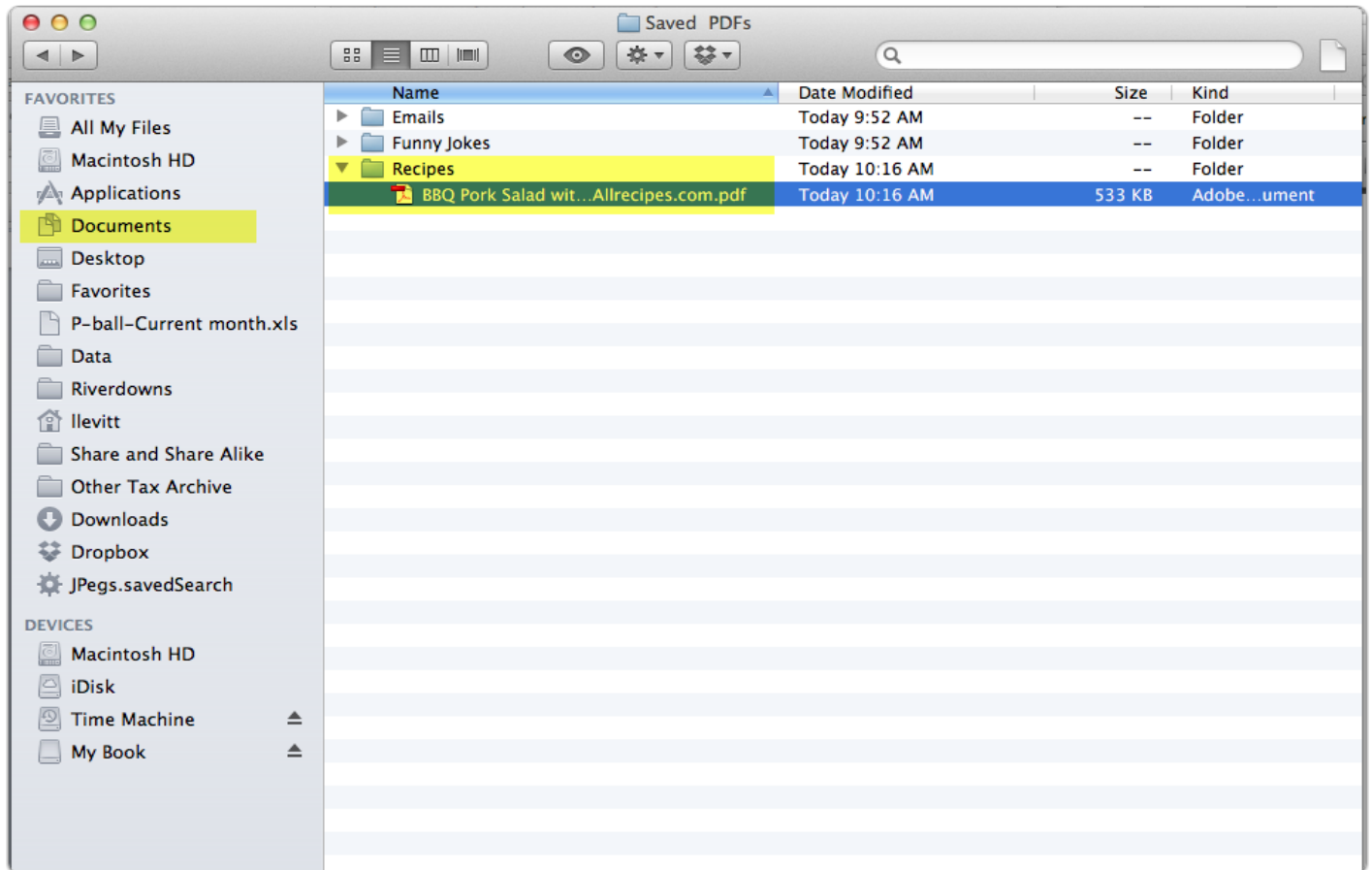

## Backing up your Mac

### Backing up your Mac

You never forget the first time your hard drive dies and you realize that you haven't backed up. The horrible, stomach-turning moment when you know you've just lost a whole bunch of stuff that's irreplaceable. Photos. Music. Videos that you took at family events. All gone.

Most of us use hard drives every day, without realizing what an amazing piece of engineering they are. Inside every hard drive are a number of extremely thin circular platters, made from glass or ceramic material, spinning at 7200rpm or more.

Leave your hard drive on all day, every day, and each platter will spin 3,784 million times in a year. Floating just nanometers away from these platters is the read/write head, the part of the drive that (as the name suggests) reads and writes data to the drive.

As the head passes over the drive, it magnetizes the surface of the platters in a series of zeros and ones. And the drive has to carry on working like this even when knocked, without crashing the head into the platter, which could easily kill the drive.

Given this, it's perhaps no surprise that hard drives fail. Generally, though, catastrophic failure is relatively rare.

It's not a matter if your hard drive is going to fail...but when!

The best back-up plan is something you don't have to think about once it is set up. The best way to set up the plan is with Time Machine, Apple's own software that comes with every Mac.





Activating one of these widgets is as simple as double-clicking it. When Dashboard is in this mode, deactivating most widgets is as simple as clicking the small "x" that appears on each widget.

If you've gone through the list of widgets already on your system and still can't find what you need, don't despair. A wealth of new widgets is just a download away. The best place to start looking is probably Apple's widget site. Many Dashboard widgets are free. Of those widgets currently listed in the top fifty on Apple's site two were shareware, two were demos, and the remaining forty-six were freeware.

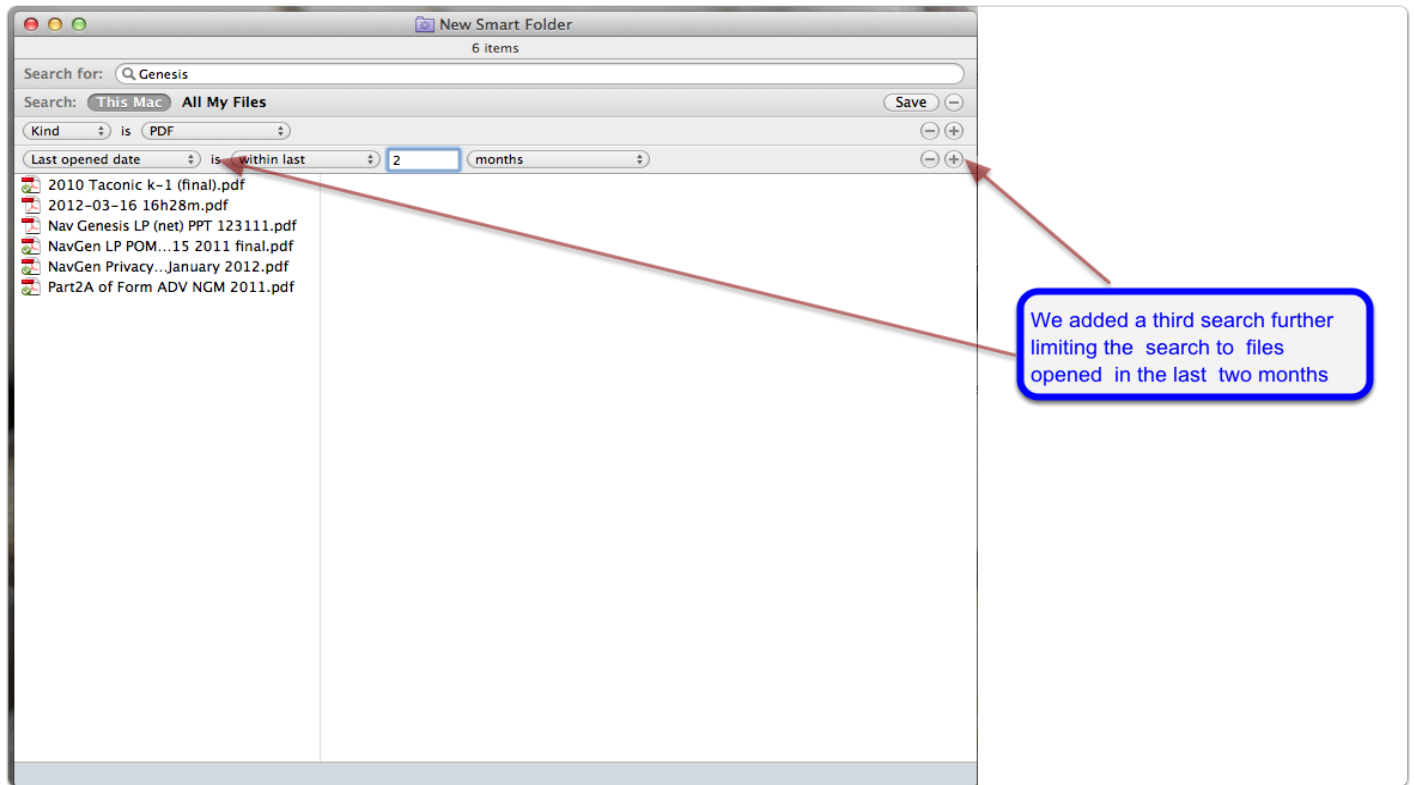
