## OS X Mavericks

- **Mavericks is Apple's newest operating system for their desktop & laptop machines. They ran out of cat names (leopards, lions, panthers, etc.) and switched to Famous California locations - in this case Mavericks, a surfing beach off the Monterey coast.**



## OS X Mavericks

- To install *Mavericks* you need to be running *Snow Leopard*, *Lion* or *Mountain Lion* and have a 2008 or newer *iMac* or *MacBook*.
- *Mavericks* is available as a free download!

# Upgrade to OS X Mavericks. Free on the Mac App Store.

For the first time, you can upgrade your Mac to the latest release of OS X for free. Just click the Mac App Store icon on your Mac. Download OS X Mavericks. And your Mac does the rest.

Follow these steps to begin your upgrade.

# 1 Check your Mac hardware.

To get details about your Mac model, click the Apple icon at the top left of your screen, choose About This Mac, then choose More Info. Click the link below to see if your Mac is compatible with OS X Mavericks.



# 2 Check your version of OS X.

While you have the About This Mac window open, check what version of OS X your Mac is running. You'll see it listed beneath your serial number.

You can upgrade to OS X Mavericks from Snow Leopard (10.6.8), Lion (10.7), or Mountain Lion (10.8). Click the link below if you have an older version of OS X.



# 3 Download OS X Mavericks.

Open the Mac App Store and click OS X Mavericks. Click the Download button. Then follow the onscreen instructions to install it. If you don't have broadband access, you can visit any [Apple Retail Store](#) to get help with downloading.

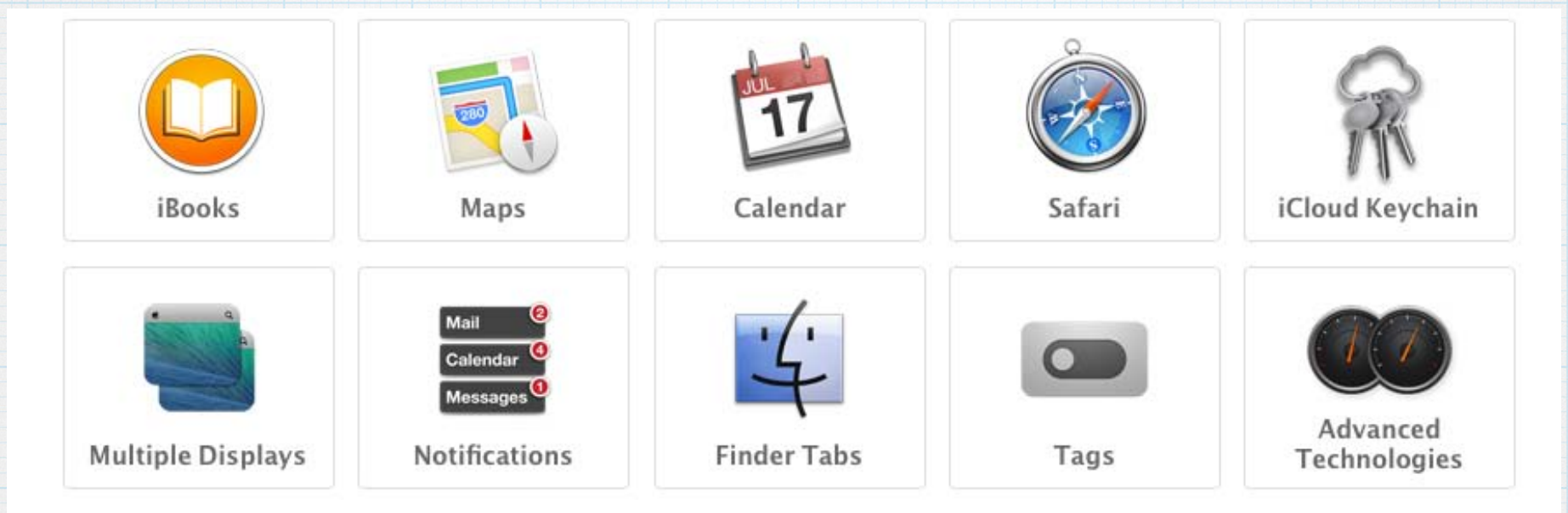

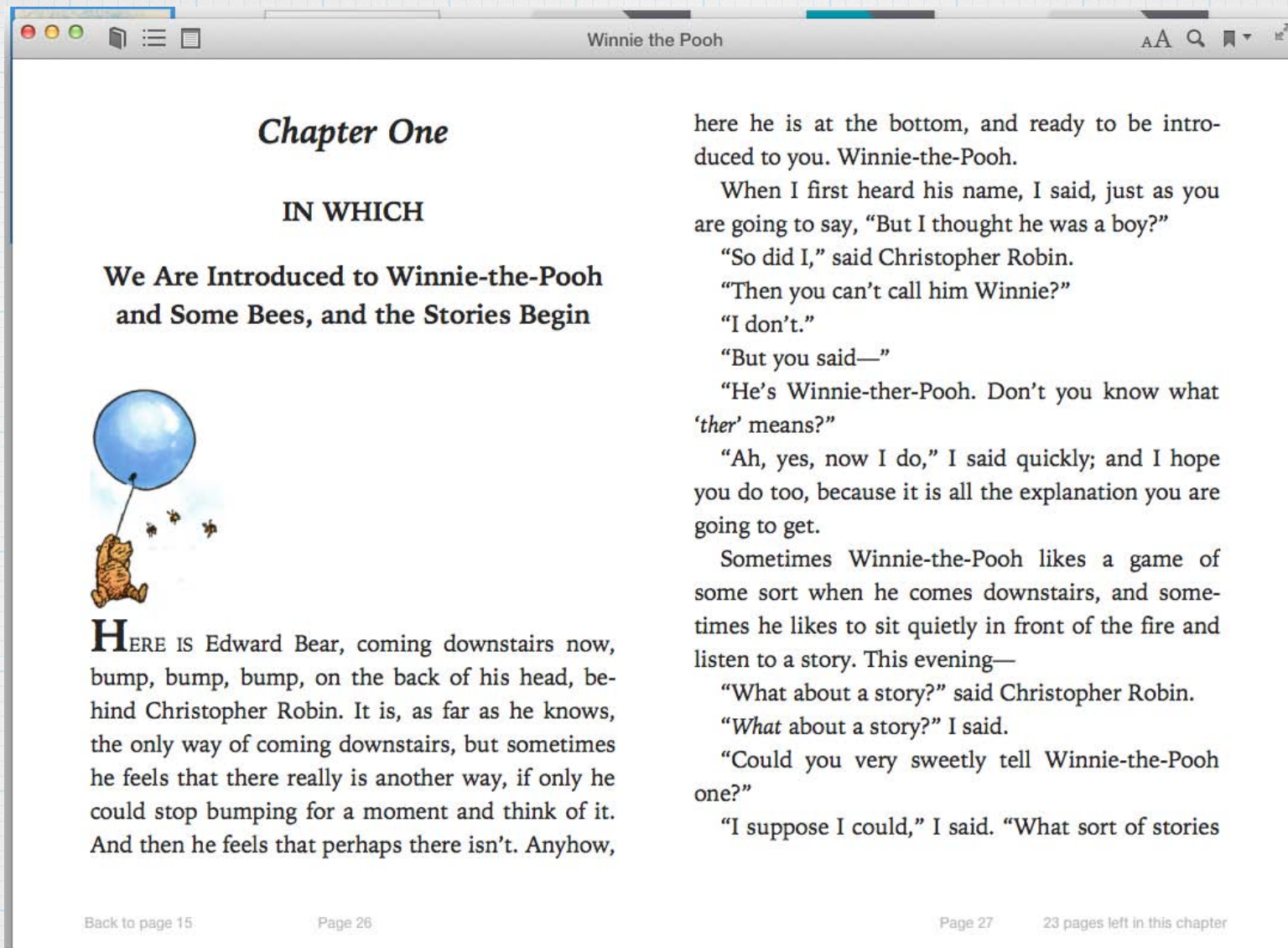


# iBooks

iBooks has come to the desktop, I prefer reading on my iPad, but Apple has done a good job with a built-in store and nice interface.

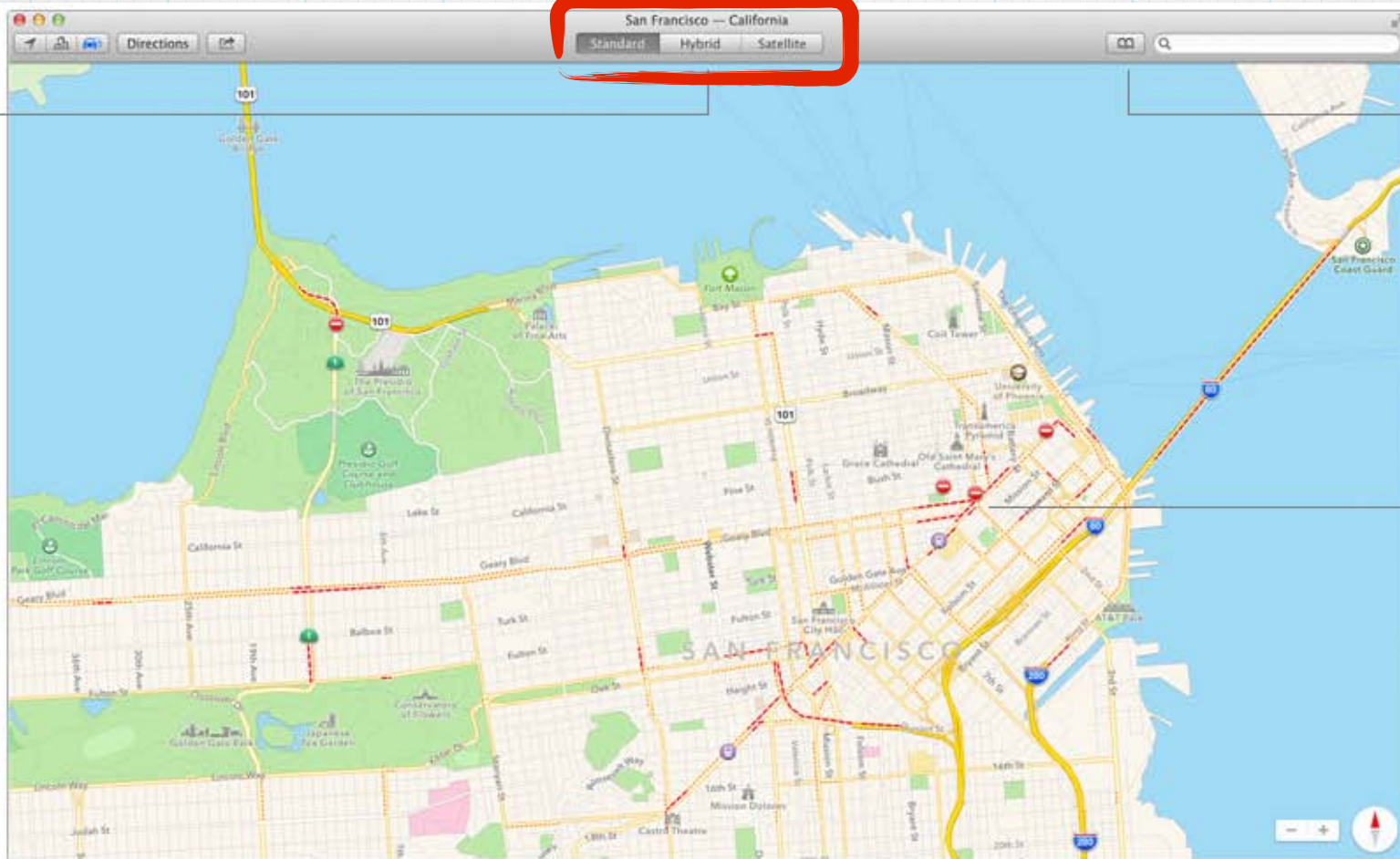


# Maps
