

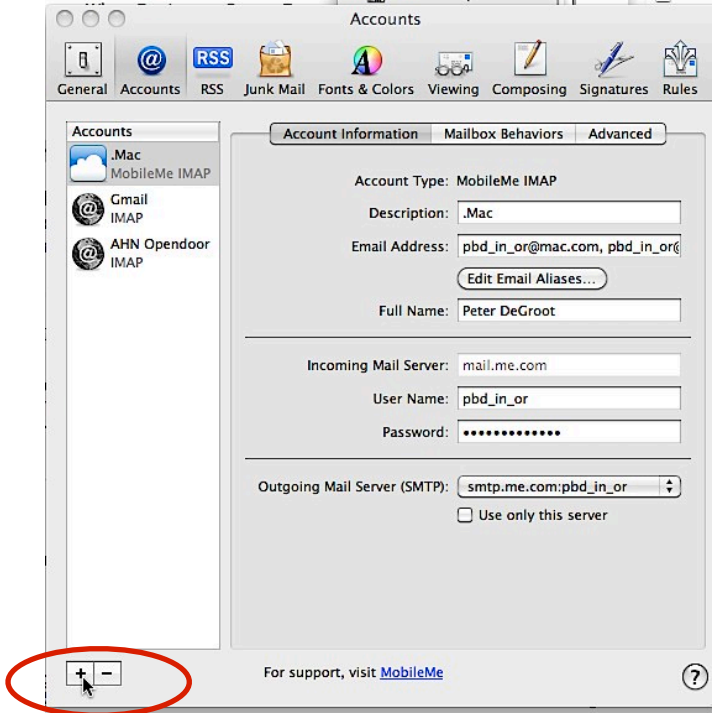
Setting up an Apple Mail account - an example

First of all

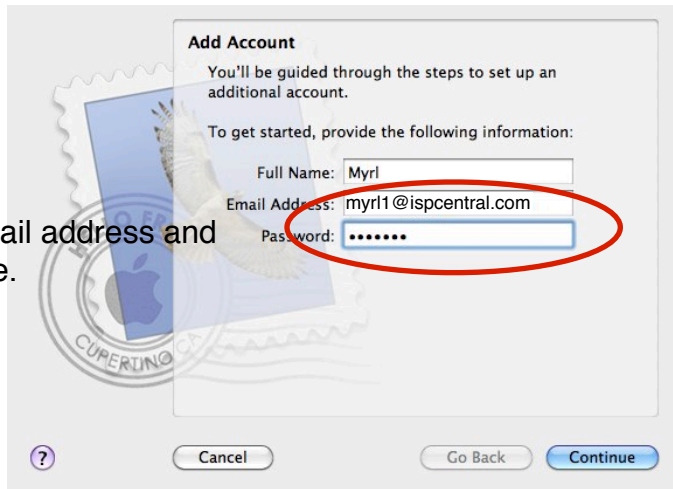
Contact your email provider beforehand and set up your desired email address and password.

Also get the type of account (POP or IMAP) and the names of the incoming and outgoing mail servers.

Next, go to Mail/Preferences and click on Accounts



Click on the + sign



Enter your email address and password here.

Then click on Continue



Choose Pop or IMAP

This is what will appear in the list of Accounts in Mail Preferences

Get the name of the incoming mail server from your email provider and enter here

Then click on Continue

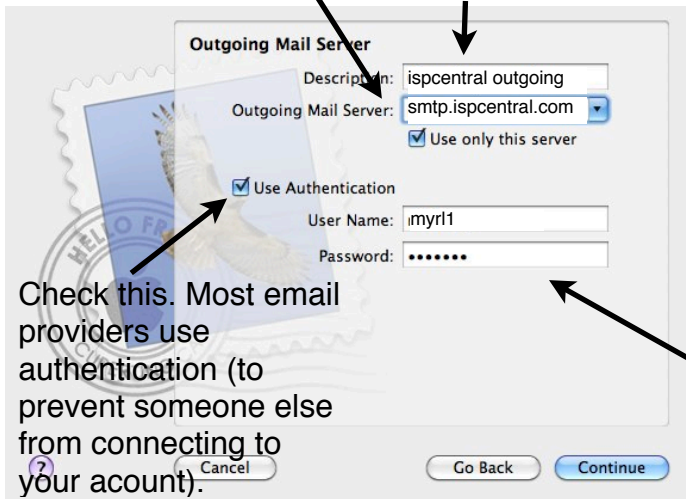
Mail will test the connection and continue

If you get this message, continue with Setup Manually

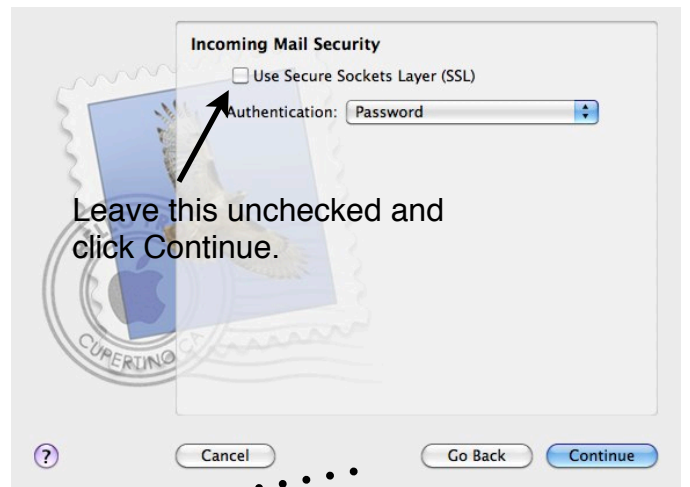


Get the name of the *outgoing* mail server from your email provider and enter it here (sometimes it will be the same as the incoming)

The description is optional



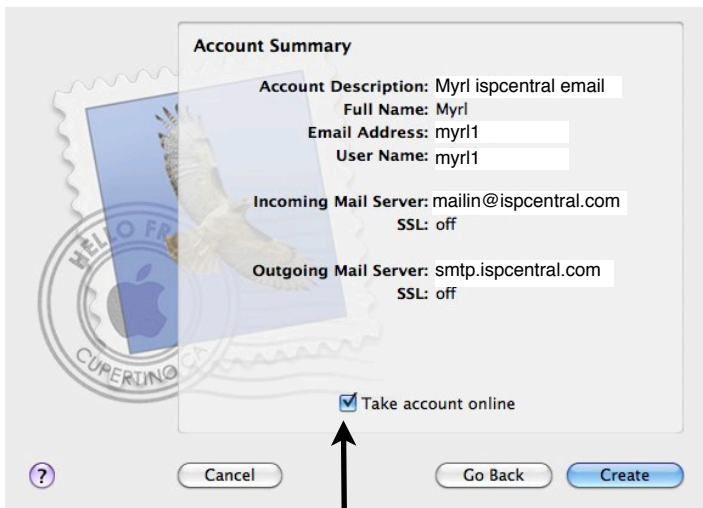
Check this. Most email providers use authentication (to prevent someone else from connecting to your account).



Leave this unchecked and click Continue.

The only differences with the Manual Set Up are the above screen, and that you will have to manually fill in the User Name and the Password under "Use Authentication" in the next screen.

Then click Continue



Make sure this is checked, then click Create
