It's basically what they do when you visit the Genius Bar at the Apple Store.

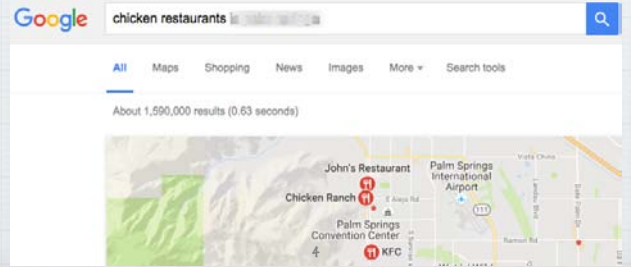

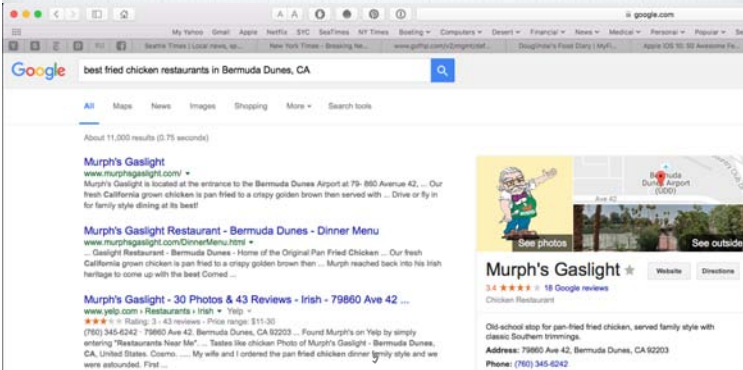
Google is great, but it's better if you get very specific.

Use more words, not less, for the best results on Google.

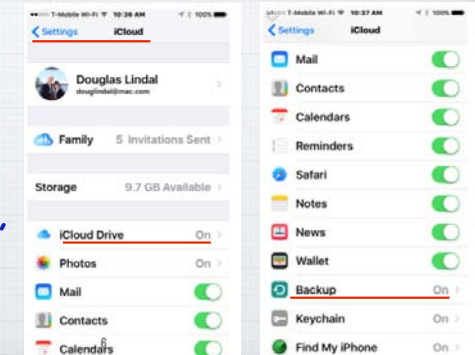

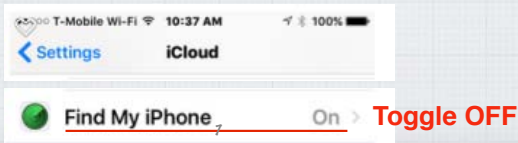
How do I prep my iPhone/iPad to give it away or sell it?

There are three important steps:

1) Back it up:
Back up all of your important data - including contacts, photos, and apps - open: Settings > iCloud

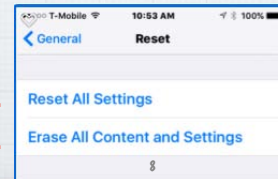


2) Turn off Find My iPhone: Find My iPhone is a security feature that must be turned off before you sell or give away your phone - or nobody else will be able to use it. Open Settings and go to iCloud > Find My iPhone and toggle it off.



3) Wipe it: Sign out of iCloud. Then, open the Settings app and go to: General > Reset > Erase All Content and Settings to erase everything from your iPhone. Once this is complete, you can also go to General > Reset > Reset All Settings to restore the iPhone to factory settings.

Selling a iPhone or iPad.

Sell it yourself or trade it in.

Talk up the news you are buying a new phone with friends, it is surprising how many know someone interested in a used iPhone.

Or use Craigslist or eBay.

Always meet Craigslist prospects at a public place like Starbucks and be prepared for flakes who don't show up!

If you don't mind putting in a little work - listing, boxing & shipping - eBay will usually get you more money and there is none of that awkward face to face negotiations.

Option 2 - Trade it in.

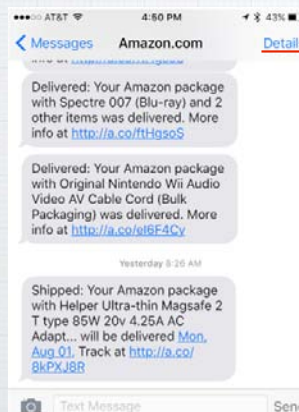
Easiest is to use is Apple's or your wireless carrier's Trade Up Program. Like a new car dealership they are convenient but pay the least.

Gazelle.com and NextWorth.com pay more but you must mail in your iPhone.

Best Buy's Trade In Plan will get you more \$\$ but only in store credits.

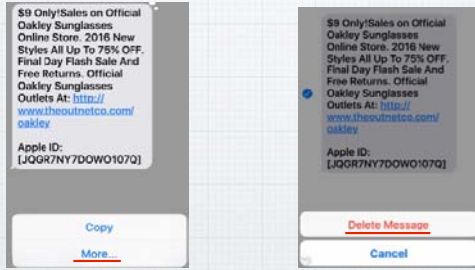

How do I delete individual Text Messages on my iPhone or iPad?



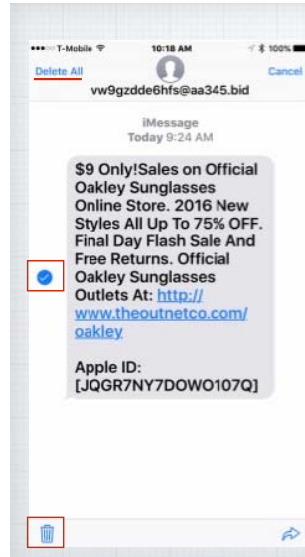
Not as easy as you might think. You can't swipe left/right to delete them and the Details button doesn't help either.

The solution is firmly tapping the message you want to delete and the "Copy-More ..." bar will open up.



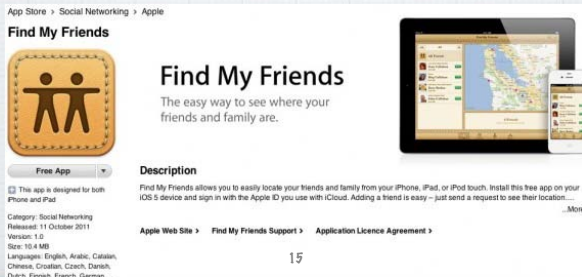
Tap on the More button, then the Delete Message button.

Options are to delete the entire message string or add a checkmark to delete any single text. I don't know why Apple made this so complicated!



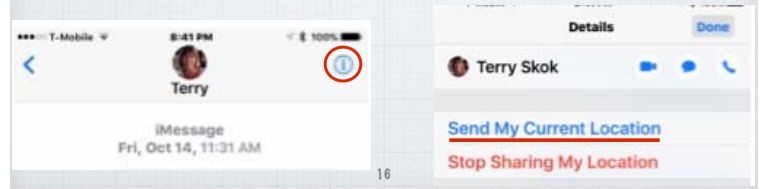
Sharing your location via Messages.

Sure you can turn on Find My Friends for everyone you know but that's kinda creepy!

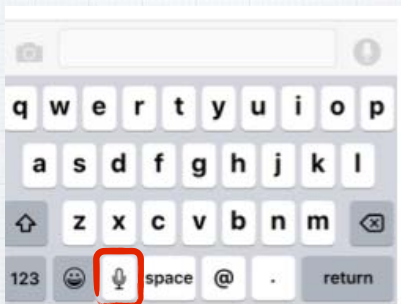


In iOS 10 Apple just made this process a lot safer and easier!

1. Open Messages.
2. Start a conversation with a friend.
3. Tap on ⓘ (Details) in the upper corner.
4. Tap on 'Send my Current Location'.



How to use Dictation on your iPad.



It's always been easy on the iPhone and iPad, just tap on the microphone in Mail, Messages or Pages.

The trick is instead of your normal speech, you need to add the punctuation.

This is neat! I'm using Apple's speech to text feature. Pretty great, isn't it?

*"This is neat Exclamation point
I'm using Apple's speech to text feature Period
New paragraph
Pretty great Comma Isn't it Question mark"*

Creating Quick Slideshows.

The permanent way to create slideshows in Photos on an iPad/iPhone (or a Mac) is to move photos into a new album. But sometimes you just want to show off today's dozen pictures from a quick trip.



Click the arrow on your Mac or your iOS device.

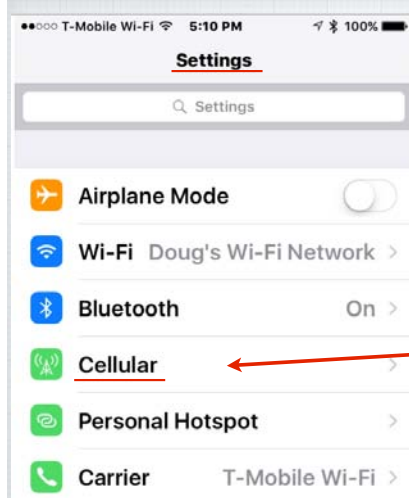
And now with iOS 10, you can craft quite a nice slideshow on your iPhone or iPad with choice of music.



What's all the controversy about some new 'WiFi Assist' feature?

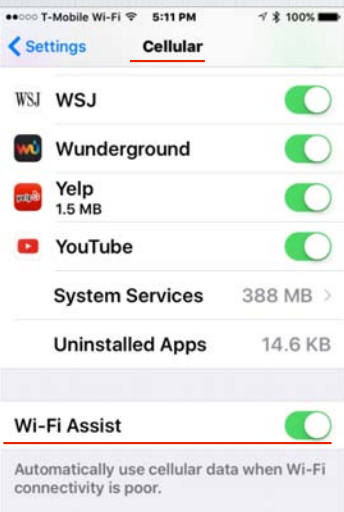
Apple added a new so-called 'feature' to iOS 9 called WiFi Assist that can really cost us a lot of money if we aren't careful. With it turned on, your iPhone uses your cellular data when your WiFi signal is weak so you can connect to the Internet. But there is no warning, and you could unknowingly run up huge cellular data bills without warning! And the worst news? Apple turns it on by default! Let's change that.

Open your iPhone Settings menu and click on Cellular

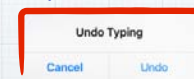


Then scroll to the very bottom of the Cellular screen and turn off Wi-Fi Assist by clicking the button so it turns from green to gray.

How do I disable 'Shake to Undo' on my iPhone!?

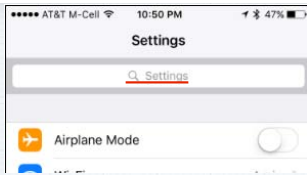
Really how many times have you had this message pop up on your iPhone screen:



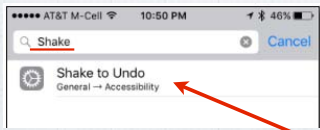
It's due to a 'cute' feature of iOS that allows you to shake your phone to undo what you have typed. But 99.9% of the time it appears just because you jiggled your phone putting it into your pocket!

Here is how to turn off this 'feature'.

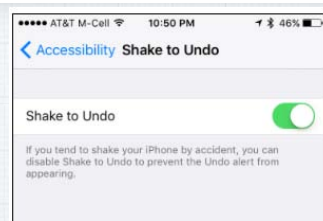

In iOS 9 there was a new Search Field added at the top of your Settings Screen. Just type in your query: **Shake**



and a possible solution pops up - buried deep in the General/Accessibility menu!



Sure enough, a way to disable the Shake to Undo option. Use this new search field to find options buried deep in the Settings Screen!



How do I add new cities to the iPhone Weather App?

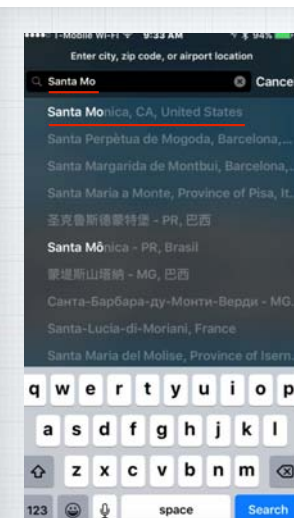
There are lots of weather Apps available, but most of us stick with Apple's version - including me. A few observations before we add or delete weather reports for new cities.



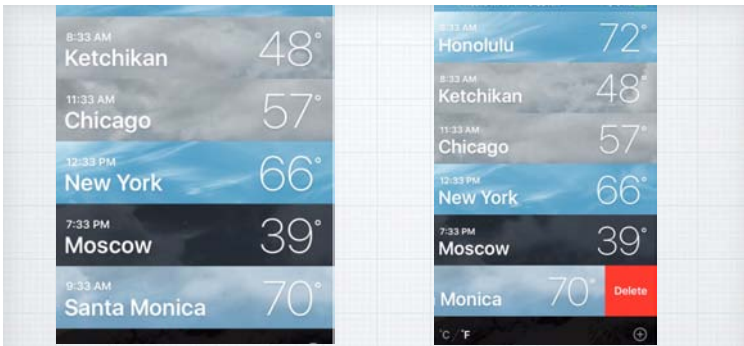
Notice first the triangle and ten dots on the bottom of my screen. This indicates I have weather for my current location and ten cities. We want to click on the 3 horizontal lines.



I actually like this view to scan all my cities at once. But now we want to add Santa Monica to our list so we click on the



Start typing 'Santa Mo...' and one of your choices is Santa Monica, just click on it to add your list.

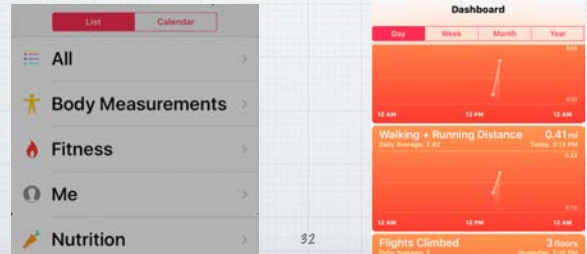


Presto, Santa Monica is added to your list. Want more detail? Just click on the city. Want to delete it? Just swipe "right to left" and click delete.

How do I set up Emergency Contacts on my iPhone?

One of best features of last year's iOS update was the new Health App. It allows you to document your medical history and a Dashboard that keeps track of your exercise programs.

But the new Health App also allows you to enter key medical and contact info so if you are unconscious, your iPhone will provide this critical information. Responders will tap on the Emergency button on your unlock screen.

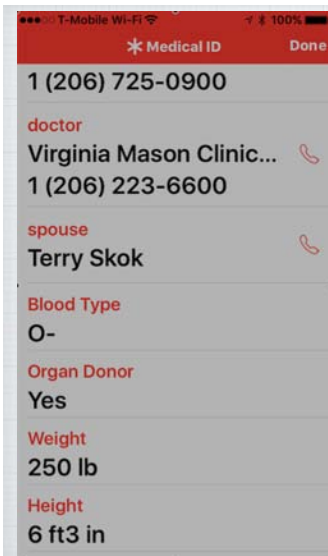

When you press the Emergency button this screen opens to allow emergency phone calls - but now also has a new Medical ID button in the lower left corner to allow access to your medical info.

(Notice it says 'Emergency Call' in a half dozen languages at the top - Appel d'urgence is French!)

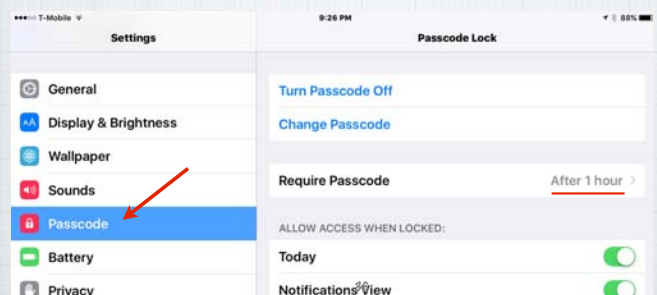


The Medical ID screen gives all the information needed to assist you in the event of an emergency, including telephone contacts.

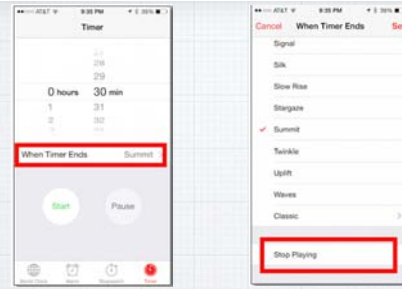
How do I add passwords to an iPad?

On a iPad or iPhone, click on Passcode (not Privacy) then 'Turn Passcode On' and select the length of time required until a password is required. I use one hour on my iPad and 5 minutes on my iPhone.



Is there an iPhone Sleep Timer for music?

If you like to go to sleep listening to music on your iPhone there is a simple way to turn off the phone after you fall asleep. But you won't find it in your Music App. Instead click on your Clock App.



Set your timer for say 30 minutes and then click on "When Timer Ends". It takes you to this second screen where you scroll down & click "Stop Playing". Sweet Dreams!

Since I installed the updates last year, my Mac and iPad ring whenever my iPhone does - how do I stop this?

It's the result of new Apple 'features' called Continuity and Handoff. Being able to answer your iPhone on your Mac is slick, but not for everyone.

Fortunately Apple recognizes this can be annoying for many and gives us a way to turn it off.

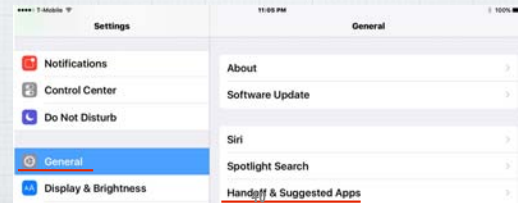
The key is realizing it is all done through FaceTime.

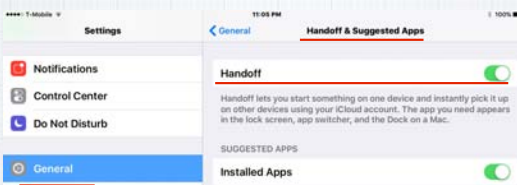


So first go into FaceTime Preferences on your Mac and uncheck "Calls From iPhone".

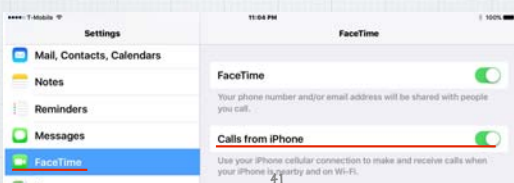
Then on your iPad go into Settings under General and click on Handoff & Suggested Apps.



Under General, leave Handoff enabled.



And under FaceTime, turn off 'Calls from iPhone'.

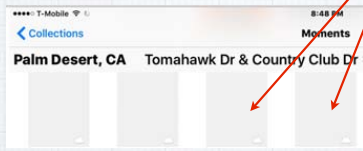
Why do my new photos take so long to show up when I open the Photos app on my iPad?

It's a function of iCloud having to transfer the new photos from 'the cloud' to your iPad. The transfer occurs quickly if you are on a fast WiFi network, quite a bit slower via cellular.

Until they show up, the little clouds appear in the Photos app -



then photos start appearing and the clouds go away.

How to track down a lost iPhone or iPad?

Fortunately Apple provides a free location tool called Find My iPhone that helps figure out if you left your phone on the bus—or if it's just in the couch cushions. First you'll need an Apple ID and an iCloud account. There's a good chance you already have both, if not, visit [iCloud.com](https://www.icloud.com), click the link "Create yours now," then follow the onscreen instructions.



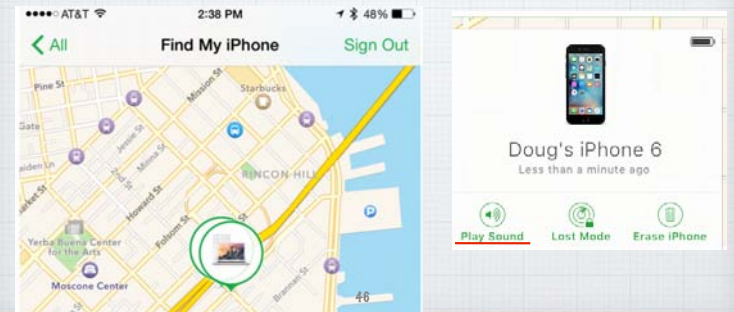

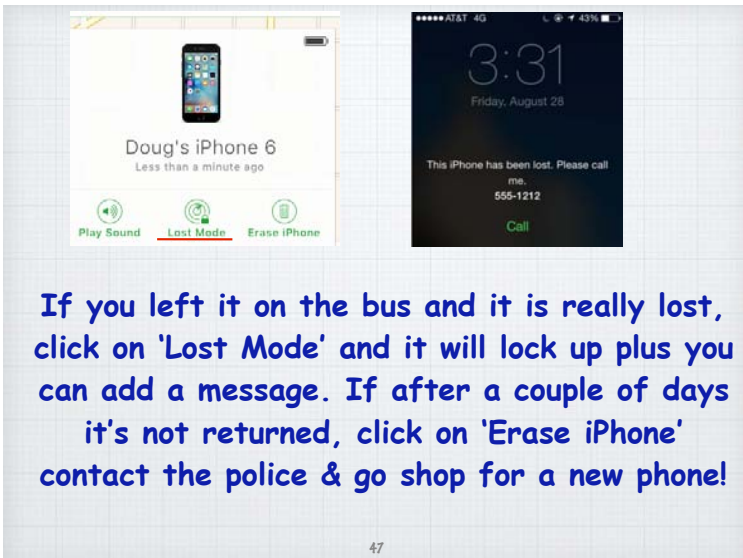

Next, hop over to your iPhone, open the Settings app, then tap iCloud. Tap Find My iPhone, and toggle the 'Find My iPhone' switch to On (it'll turn green) and you are all set. While there toggle on 'Send Last Location'.

If your iPhone goes missing, visit [iCloud.com](https://www.icloud.com) from any computer and click on 'Find My iPhone', and a map appears with it's location. If it's just misplaced at your current location, click the 'Play Sound' button to help locate it.



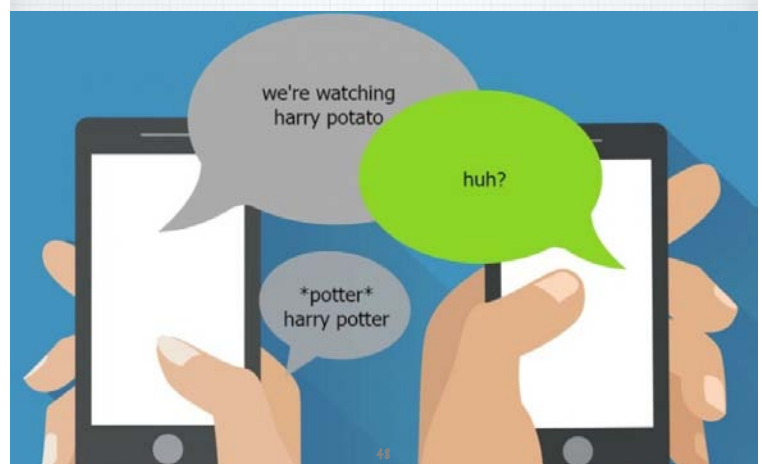

If you left it on the bus and it is really lost, click on 'Lost Mode' and it will lock up plus you can add a message. If after a couple of days it's not returned, click on 'Erase iPhone' contact the police & go shop for a new phone!

Damn you autocorrect!

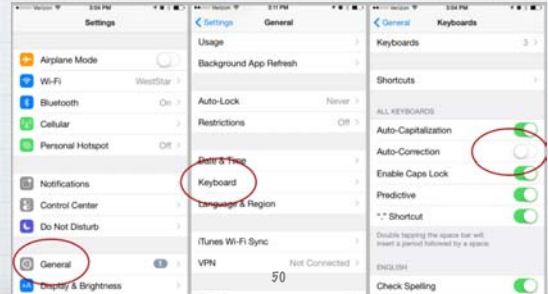

Autocorrect (AC) is the scourge of all iOS users. Not paying attention and the message you send can be quite different from the one you intended! Here are five ways to control it.

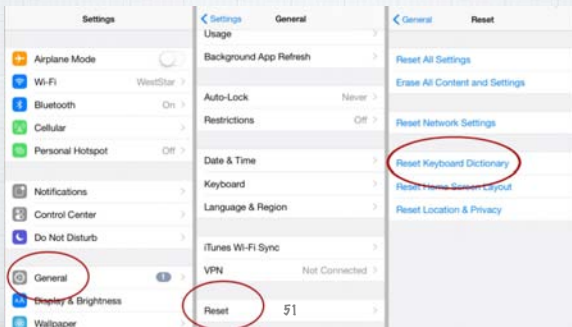
1. Turn off Autocorrect

If you'd like to just sidestep the entire problem altogether, the easiest way is to turn it off. Turning off Autocorrect is an option for anyone who isn't too worried about typos.



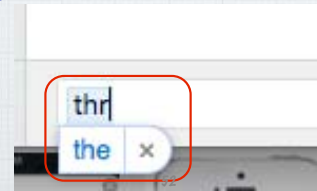
2. Reset Your Keyboard Dictionary.

Over time, you may accidentally save words to your dictionary that aren't correct. Try "rebooting" your keyboard's dictionary.



3. Train Autocorrect (AC) as you go.

When you misspell a word in iOS, AC jumps in with the correct spelling. Just hit the spacebar or tap on the word to accept the AC suggestion. But be careful - if you are typing THROW, AC will suggest THE as soon as you type THR. Click the X to train it!



4. Text Replacement.

For phrases you use a lot, like "on my way" you can create a shortcut in your settings. Then type in OMW and it will be auto-converted to: "On my way!"



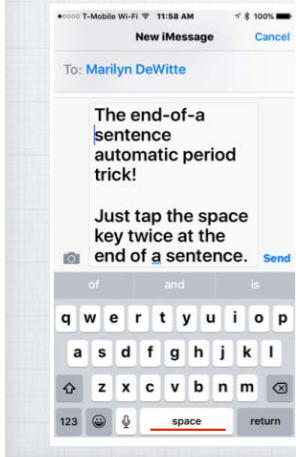
5. Turn off Predictive Text.

Predictive Text are the word suggestions that pop up above your keyboard when typing in Mail or Messages -

Turn off by holding down the emoji key and click off 'Predictive'.

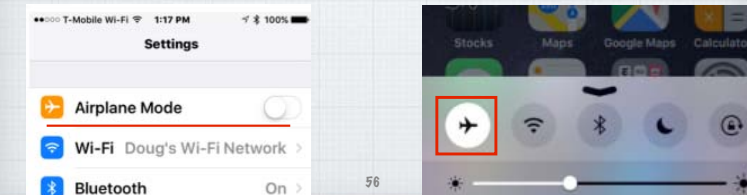
The End of Sentence Trick.

Always end a sentence with a double tap of the Space Bar. This adds a period, then a space and then capitalizes the next letter - all in one step! (Now works on Macs too!)

How to quickly charge a dead iPhone?

Plug it into the wall with your charger -that is twice as fast as a laptop USB jack. Then put it into Airplane mode which focuses all the power into charging. How to turn it on? Use Settings Menu or swipe up from bottom of the home screen to open Quick Settings screen.



Hidden Pop-Up Keys in iOS



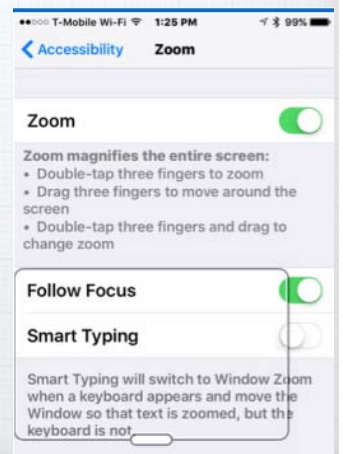
A great shortcut for typing web addresses - Just press on the period key for common options.

How to add the accent to properly spell café? Just hold down on the E key for options to appear. (This works on Macs too.)

Zoom in on your iPhone or iPad

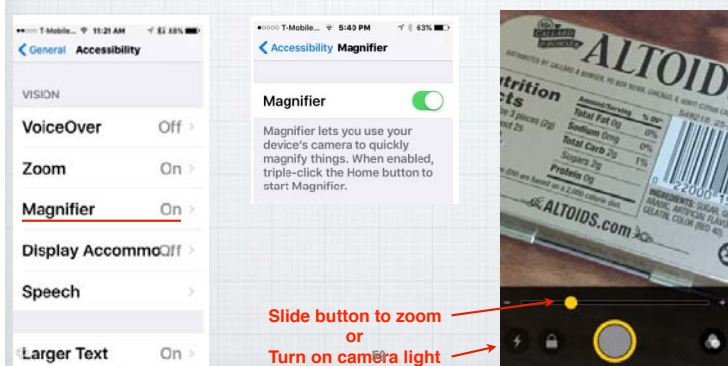
If some type is too tiny, here are two tips. Open Settings-General-Accessibility & turn on Larger Text & Bold Text. Then turn on Zoom - you'll double tap three fingers to zoom and move the box around like a magnifying glass.



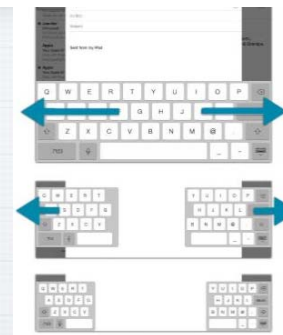

Use Your iPhone As a Magnifying Glass.

Settings/General/Accessibility - Magnifier
Triple tap Home Button to activate & zoom.



Slide button to zoom or Turn on camera light



The Secret iPad Thumbs Keyboard.

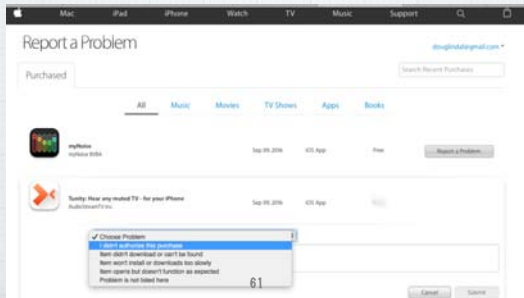
It's tough to stretch your thumbs to type on an iPad! So put your thumbs on the keyboard and "pull" it apart to type near the edges.

How to Get a Refund from Apple.

Did you buy an App you hate? Get the wrong one? You can usually get a refund, but Apple doesn't make the process obvious!

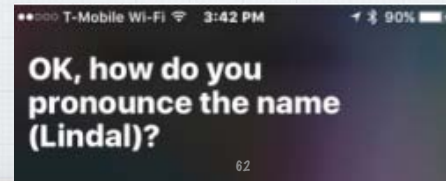

How to get Siri to pronounce your name?

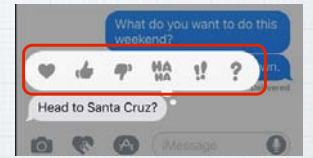

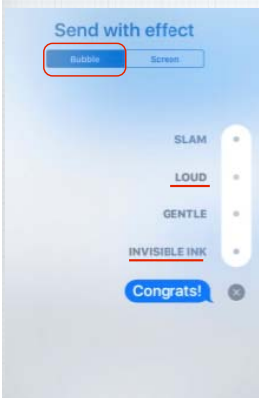
Just turn your device to landscape mode, it will allow you to **handwrite messages** - or chose a stock response.

Type a message, and press and hold the blue circled arrow. You'll have options to 'Send with effect' - I like LOUD and Invisible Ink!



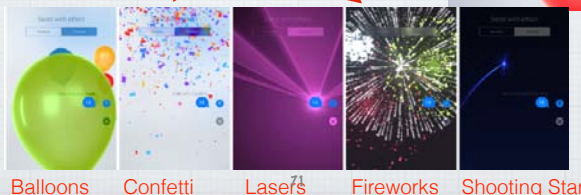
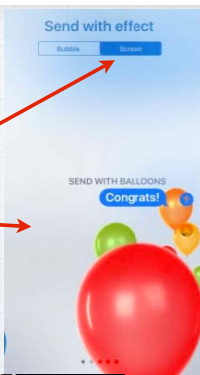
Invisible Ink!

Just text your surprise to a friend and the photo will magically appear!



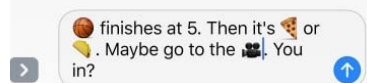
Screen Effects!

Or chose Screen Effects and pick balloons or other options.



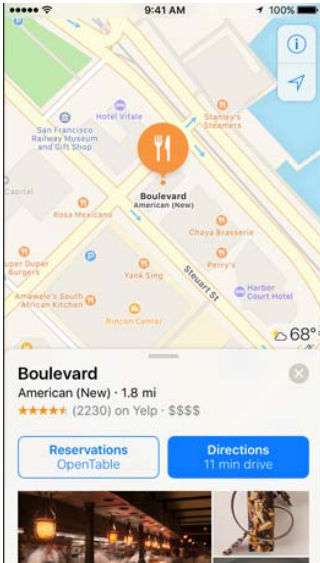
Emoji Fun!

(tap the Smiley Face) and select words in your text to auto replace with emoji.

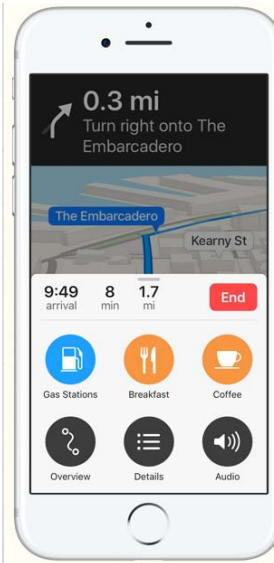

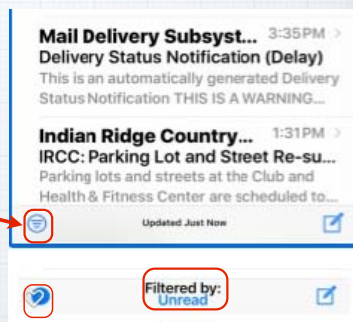


Flyover.

Mail Updates.

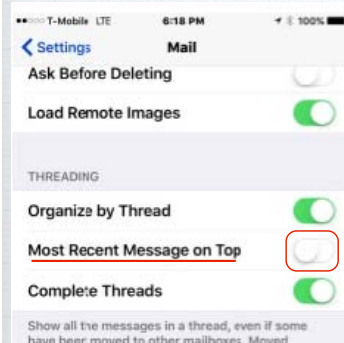
Click to Filter messages to show only new 'unread' messages.

In Settings/Mail turn on 'Most Recent Message on Top' to restore the old method of putting new messages back on top of the string.

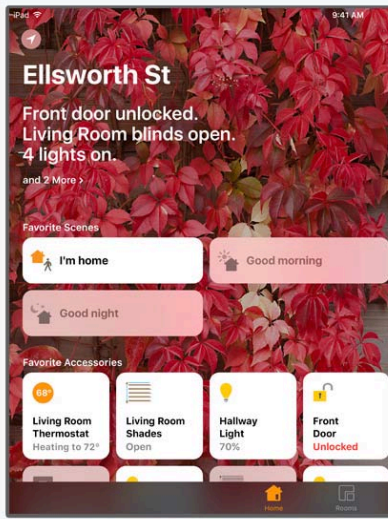

Raise to Wake.

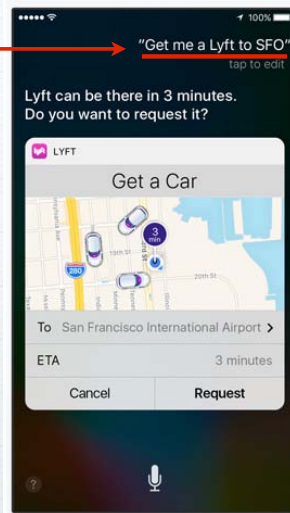

Siri now works

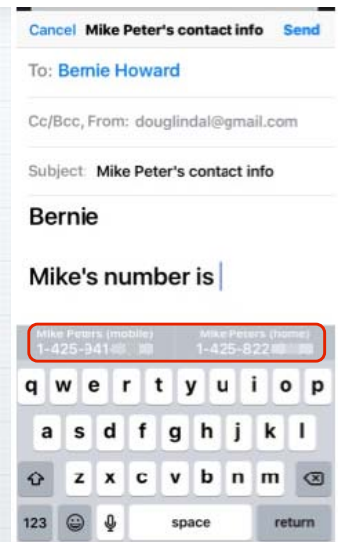
with your favorite apps from the App Store, so you can ask it to book a ride through Uber or Lyft, or send money to someone with Square Cash.

Contextual Predictions.

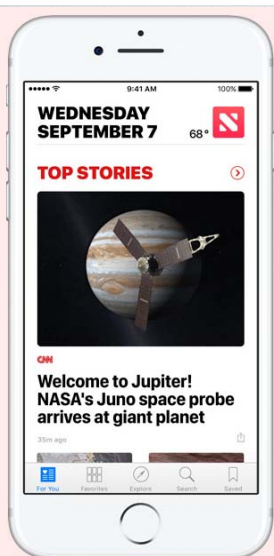
Typing is quicker and easier than ever. Start typing a phone number or address and iOS will attempt to predict the response.

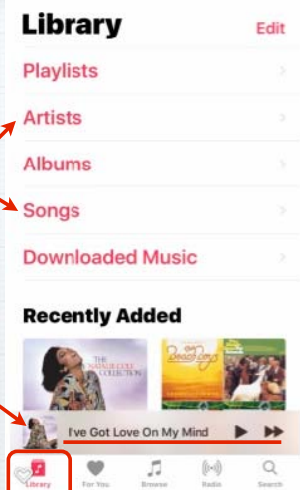
Easily find the stories that matter to you most, in distinct sections of the redesigned News App.

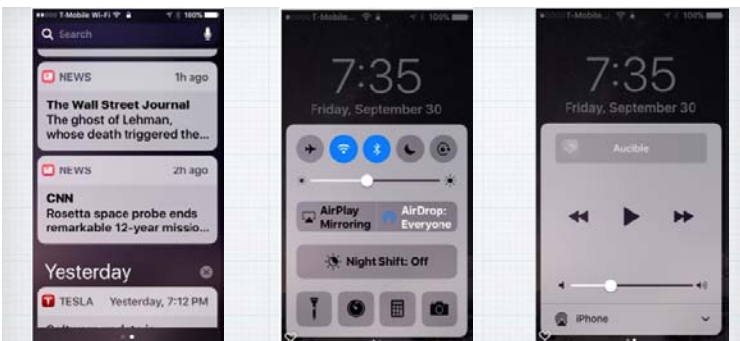
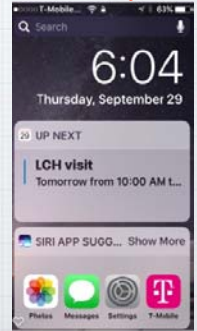
Pick up your phone and swipe left to right for camera, or right to left for the Today View.



Swipe right for camera

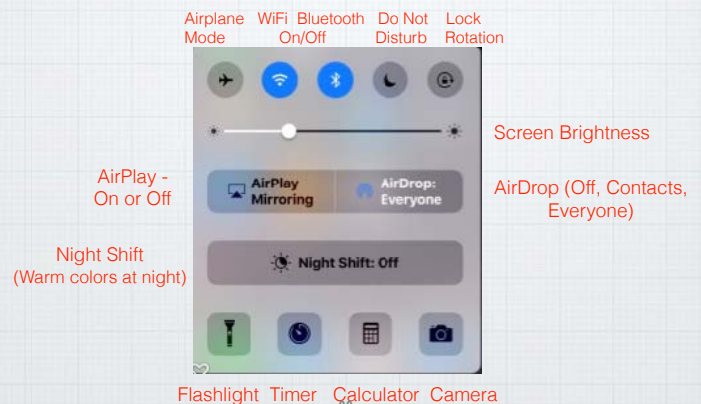


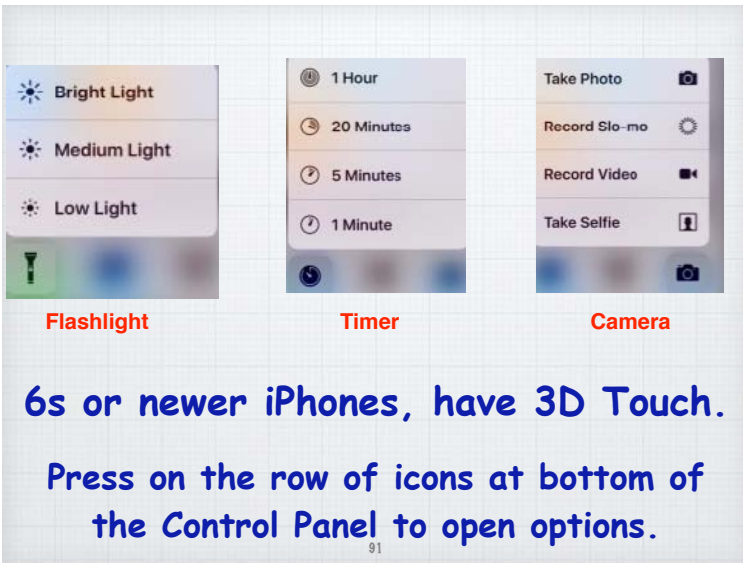
Left for Today View

The Control Panel does more in iOS 10. Swipe up from the bottom to reveal it.





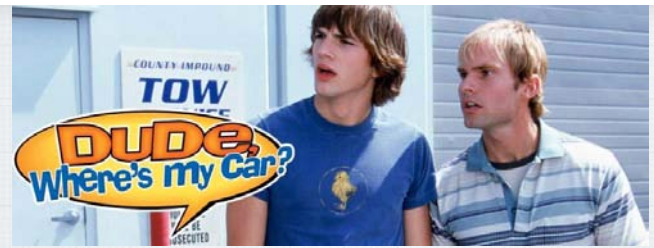

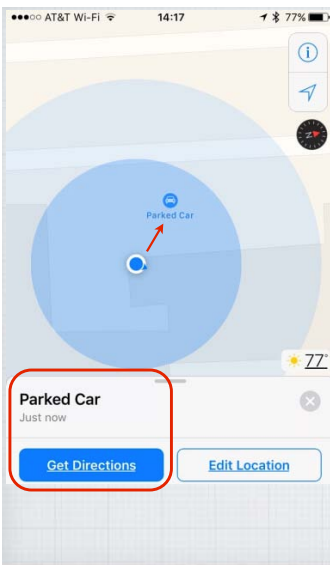
6s or newer iPhones, have 3D Touch.

Press on the row of icons at bottom of the Control Panel to open options.



Parked Car feature.

Your iPhone can now help you find where you parked your car.

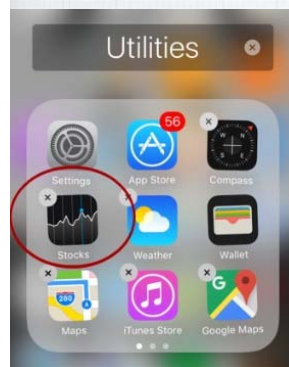


With iOS 10, any trip that doesn't end at your home, saves the car location in Maps (due to the Bluetooth connection in the car) so you can find the car easily later.

Great for shopping trips to the mall.

Delete Apple Apps.

One of the annoying little things for many users has been Apple's refusal to allow you to delete their own Apps - with iOS 10 you can remove Stocks, Numbers, Compass - or add them back anytime from the App Store.
