

What is it?

- Twitter and social media are forms of electronic communication
- Allows anyone to have the microphone
 - People/brands build their own audiences
 - Changes who controls the message
- Twitter was the first social media application created for mobile
 - Hence the 140 character limit as it's particular differentiator
- But Twitter has now grown into a very powerful platform

It changed the world!

- Prior to Gutenberg, most knowledge and information was owned and controlled by a very few. Scribes recorded information for the select few.
- After the printing press, the masses gained access to books, newspapers.
- Knowledge could be recorded, passed down and shared by many.



WHY should you be interested?

- · If you think Twitter is just 140 characters that you send to your grandkids, you are 3 years behind the times!
- Twitter (and other social media) is the Gutenberg printing press of our time.






Before Social Media and After


- NBC, CBS, ABC had the microphone and broadcast to the masses
- · Then, more arrived -CNN, FOX, MSNBC, Breitbart, etc had the microphone and broadcast to the masses.
- Now the masses have the microphones and they broadcast to each other!
 - Example the quv with the video camera on the United Airlines flight

Getting Started - Vocabulary

- Tweet (n. or v.) a
 message you create on
 Twitter (n.) or the act of
 sending a message (v. "to
 tweet")
- @username your Twitter handle, as in @realdonaldtrump, @sallyn
 - @ is associated with people you want to address or mention)
- Following- you follow the people whose tweets you want to see in your feed
- Followers are people who want to see your tweets

More Vocabulary

- <u>Retweet -</u> forwarding a message you receive to your followers (v. "to retweet" or n.)
- Mention including the @username in your tweet
- <u>Trending</u> the most popular topics of the day

- Hashtag or #phrase
 - a way of organizing and sorting for subjects, as in #NFLdraft
 - # is associated with subjects, including people that you want to search for, add to database for others to find

- Follow your favorite sports team
 - Or the grandkids' favorite teams or schools
- Companies you are invested in
- Companies where your kids and grandkids work
- Your Congressman or Senator, your political party, your candidate
- Thinking of a new hybrid car or a solar system
 - Follow those subjects, those brands. Get educated about what is coming
- Follow your favorite celebrity, or fashion brand, or whatever!!


Follow live action/commentary


- During the Presidential debates search #debate or #topic and watch a stream of commentary
- Watch NFL live and "tweet"
- During the Oscars or Red Carpet, see what people are saying by search #Oscars 2017
- Search "trending" on Twitter and see what people are talking about on a particular day.
 - This morning as I write, Trump's comments on Andrew Jackson and the Civil War are a "trending topic" and you can watch commentary
